

## Infrared Heater Test Bench Items Checklist

- 1. Control Panel
- 2. 480V Power Cord
- 3. 240V Power Cord
- 4. Mating Plug w/Leads for 480V Power Cord
- 5. Mating Plug w/Leads for 240V Power Cord
- 6. Infrared Heater Assembly
- 7. Marinite Board
- 8. Scissor Lift

## **Infrared Heater Test Bench Setup Instructions**

- 1. Watch video for how to properly setup and connect the Control Panel and Infrared Heater Panel.
- 2. It is recommended that 2 people set up the Test Panel.
- 3. A Certified Electrician is required to wire the power supply to the Test Panel.
- 4. Make sure your main power supply is turned off prior to starting setup.
- 5. Setup Control Panel on flat surface.
- 6. Setup Infrared Heater Panel on flat surface. Use the spring-loaded handles to unlock the Infrared Heater Panel. Panel legs must be open 90 degrees. (Reference photos and video)
- 7. Setup Scissor Lift under Infrared Panel and then place Marinite Board on top of Scissor Lift. Adjust to whatever height is needed.
- 8. Plug in the Infrared Heater Power Cord into the bottom outlet on the Control Panel.
- 9. Plug in the Sensor Plug next to the Infrared Heater Power Cord outlet on the Control Panel.
- 10. Plug in Power of 240V or 480V power plugs supplied on the top outlet on the Control Panel.
- 11. Connect the opposite end to your main power supply.
- 12. Turn on your main power supply.
- 13. Switch the Control Panel to the ON position.
- 14. Adjust Temperature Control for desired heat.

## **Infrared Heater Test Bench Disassembly Instructions**

- 1. Watch video for how to properly disassemble the Control Panel and Infrared Heater Panel.
- 2. Switch the Control Panel to the OFF position.
- 3. Turn off your main power supply.

- 4. Unplug the Control Panel from main power supply.
- 5. Let the Infrared Heater cool down for 15-30 minutes.
- 6. Unplug the 240V or 480V plug from the Control Panel.
- 7. Unplug the Sensor plug from the Control Panel.
- 8. Unplug the Infrared Heater Power Cord from the Control Panel.
- 9. Remove Marinite Board and Scissor Jack from underneath the Infrared Heater.
- 10. Fold the Infrared Heater Panel frame using the spring-loaded handles to collapse. (Reference photos and video)
